MEAL INFORMATION FOR SCHOOL CLOSURES

The Val Verde Unified School District Food Services program will provide an opportunity for families to drive through and pick up meals for the children in their family at select school sites. This program will be solely for the pick-up of meals. Meals will not be consumed on-site. We encourage families to continue to be proactive in reducing the risk of COVID-19 by not congregating at the school site once meals have been distributed, continue to wash their hands often, sneeze or cough into a tissue and stay home if they are sick.
