2.1 Step up Transition – 20 clients pending transition

Background: The Step-Up Transition Team goal is to successfully transition all clients into a new PSH project before they go back onto the street. On March 19, 2020 the CES Oversight Committee approved the following:

- 1.) All PSH beds to go to Step-Up clients until all their clients have been transitioned to other projects and
- 2.) Approve Step-Up clients from PSH to transition to any available RRH.

There are approximately 20 Step-Up PSH clients who have not yet been linked to a new PSH or RRH Program. JFSS has some PSH vacancies coming live that may potentially help 4 – 5 clients from the Coachella Valley and HomeConnect reports two potential PSH vacancies becoming available. There are still approximately 14 clients in need of linkage to a new PSH program. While the use of RRH has been approved, further approval is needed to ensure that clients transitioning to RRH can be connected to PSH as it becomes available. Step Up's program is set to expire on 9/30/20 and their budget will not allow them to carry these many clients through this date.

Recommended Motion: Prioritize Step-up clients who transition into available CES Rapid Re-housing beds (RRH) to Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH) beds as they become available.
