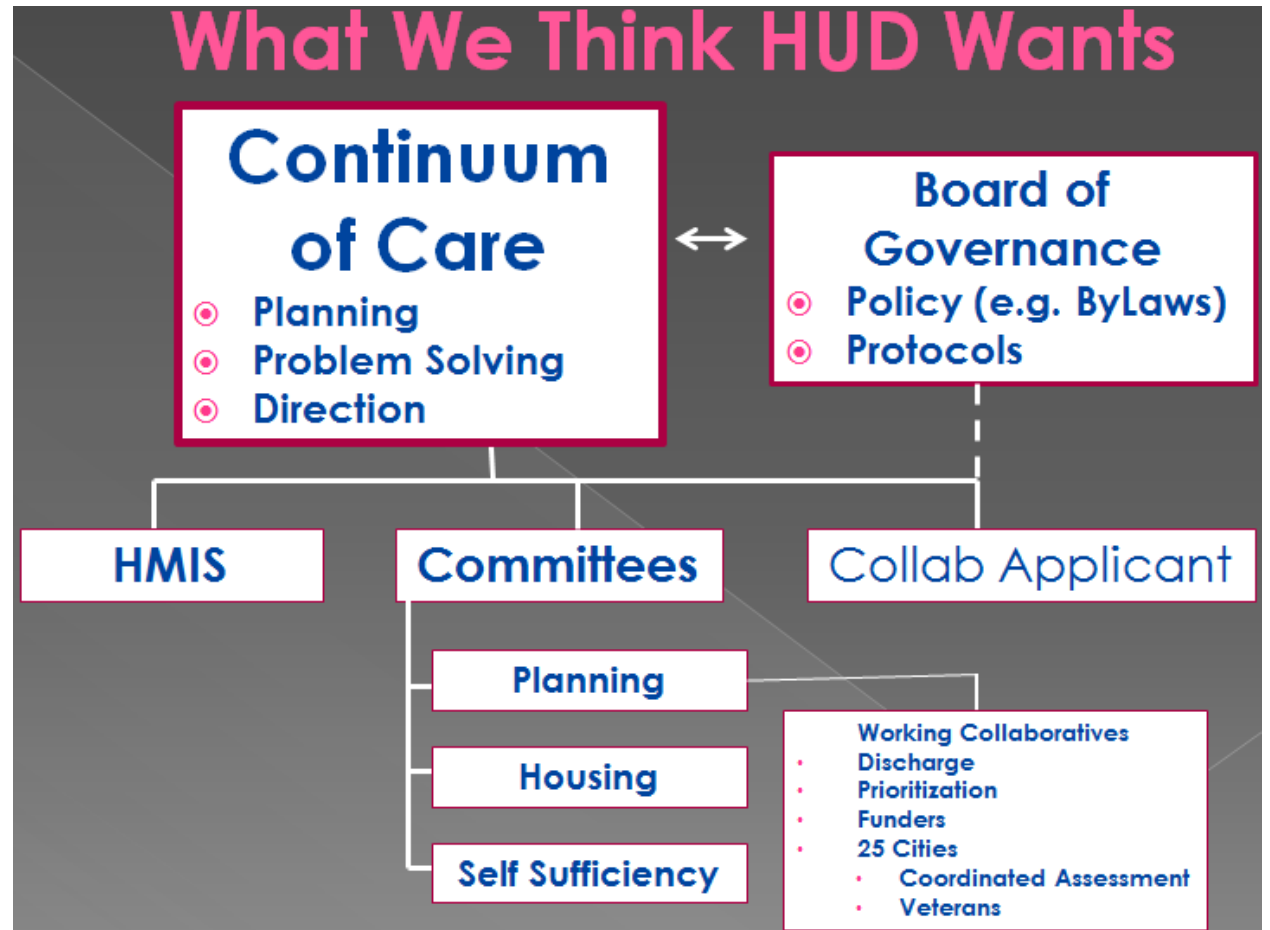

<u>Homeless Point in Time Count</u>	Rick Pettet	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rick presented a handout of upcoming volunteer training sessions and another handout presenting the key leaders in each community. • We need at least 450 volunteers within the entire county • We are doing a pilot process to connect with homeless veterans to services on the day of the count. • We are doing another pilot process to reach out to homeless youth, especially in Riverside and Indio. • Donations are needed towards incentives.
<u>Update on the 25 Cities Initiative</u>	Amy Bruno, DMH Monica Sapien, City of Riverside	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Amy gave a brief update on the 25 Cities initiative • Monica provided handouts that illustrated the 25 Cities process and explained what could be expected of the 25 Cities Community Design Team in the next 100 days. • We currently only have 9 housing navigators and are in need of many more. • In order to successfully match homeless persons to housing, we need housing inventory. • A Navigators training is being currently being organized
